WBRC Architects • Engineers 2017 Centennial Scholarship for High School Seniors

GENERAL INFORMATION:

One award each of \$500 (one for architecture, one for engineering) is available to Maine high school seniors and will be given annually at the high school's award recognition night or equivalent.

The architecture school or engineering school being attended must be recognized as an accredited college by the appropriate licensing group.

Application forms must be received by WBRC Architects • Engineers, Attn: Scholarship Committee, 44 Central Street, Bangor, Maine, 04401, through the guidance office of each high school by May 1, 2017. Applications may be scanned and emailed to miranda.jones@wbrcae.com.

It is the intention of WBRC to make awards annually, but the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withhold awards when no suitable candidate is identified.

The awards will be given to the recipient upon satisfactory completion of the first semester of post-secondary education and will be payable to the recipient.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The recipient must be accepted to, and must attend, a two- or four-year post-secondary educational institution with a major in architecture or engineering.

The recipient must have at least a 2.5 grade point average at the end of the first semester. A grade transcript must be provided to WBRC's Scholarship Committee within one month after grades are distributed.
