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## 100th Year Architectural and Engineering Scholarships for High School Students

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

Two awards of \$250 (one for Architecture and one for Engineering) are available to area High School students and will be given annually at an area High School's Award Recognition Night or equivalent.

The Architecture School and Engineering School being attended must be recognized as an accredited college by the appropriate licensing group.

The selection of the award recipient(s) will be made in conjunction with WBRC Committee and area High School Guidance Offices.

Application forms must be sent to WBRC Architects / Engineers through the guidance office of each High School.

It is the intention of WBRC to make awards annually, but the committee reserves the right to withhold awards when no suitable candidate is identified.

The awards will be given to the recipient(s) upon satisfactory completion of the first semester of the post-secondary education and will be payable to the recipient. One each will be given to both architecture and engineering disciplines.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

The recipient must be accepted to, and must attend, a 2- or 4-year post-secondary educational institution with a major in architecture or engineering.

The recipient shall have displayed good citizenship through participation in school and community activities.

The recipient must have at least a 2.5 grade point average, but grade point alone will not be the deciding factor.

**NOTE:** It is in your best interest to take the time to provide well-thought-out, complete, and well-structured answers to all the questions. The selection committee can only consider your application based on the information you provide.
