WBRC Architects Engineers Centennial Scholarship for Maine High School Seniors

GENERAL INFORMATION

Two competitive awards each of \$500 (one for architecture, one for engineering) are available to Maine high school seniors and will be given annually at the high school's award recognition night or equivalent.

The architecture school or engineering school being attended must be recognized as an accredited college by the appropriate licensing group.

Application forms must be received by WBRC Architects Engineers, Attn: Scholarship Committee, 44 Central Street, Bangor, Maine, 04401, by May 1. Applications may be scanned and emailed to tori.britton@wbrcae.com.

Applications must include official high school transcript for verification of GPA.

The \$500 awards will be given to winning recipients upon satisfactory completion of the first semester of post-secondary education and will be payable to the recipient.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The recipient must be accepted to, and must attend, a two- or four-year post-secondary educational institution with a major in architecture or engineering.

The recipient must have at least a 2.5 grade point average at the end of the first semester. An official grade transcript must be provided to WBRC's Scholarship Committee within one month after grades are distributed.
